5. Fire fighting measures

Suitable extinguishing media : Water spray, Foam, Dry powder, Carbon dioxide, Sand.

Unsuitable extinguishing media : Do not use a heavy water stream.

Explosion hazard : May induce explosion of containers by heating.

Hazardous decomposition products in case of fire : In case of fire, product may produce irritative or toxic fumes/gases.
